New Features Available May 19, 2012

Credible continues its commitment to support the client-agency relationship with a new messaging function in the Credible Client Portal and a messaging hub in your Credible system. Clients initiate the communication and the appropriate staff use the messaging hub to respond. And on the treatment planning front, there are two new ways to save your staff time and help your agency standardize treatment plans:

- Contract to have Wiley treatment plan libraries integrated into the Tx Plus module. When you select a Wiley treatment plan, predefined problems and associated goals, objectives, and interventions are available via dropdowns.
- Create and use Tx Plus templates create the templates from scratch or from existing Tx Plus plans.

Two other highlights of Release 7.1 include the ability to report e-prescribing G-codes and a new Billing Groups assignment function — you can now control which billing groups are available to staff when signing and submitting or updating a visit.

Please refer to the *Release 7.1 Configuration* document for the steps to configure and use all of the new features.

Secure Client Communication via Credible Client Portal

With the new Messaging function in the Credible Client Portal, a client user can securely send a general message to your agency or one about an active medication or scheduled appointment. If the message type is Medication



Refill or Scheduled Appointment, the client user selects from a list of the client's active meds or appointments scheduled for the current date and future dates. Note that with the first release of the Messaging functionality, messages can only originate from a client user.

The new function utilizes offline messaging and the messages are not delivered via email. You can configure "disclaimer text" to convey the offline nature of the Messaging function to client users. As shown below, the text displays above the Messaging screens in the Client Portal.



A client user does not pick the recipient for the message. By default, it goes to the client's case manager. If one is not assigned, the message goes to all primary employees for the client. If there are no primary employees, it goes to all employees assigned to the client.

In your Credible system, an envelope icon displays in the banner to notify employees that a message has been sent from the Client Portal. Hover over the icon to see the number of new messages and replies. You can control how frequently the system checks for new messages with the Check Message Interval setting in Partner Config.





Employees access the Messaging Hub screen by clicking the envelope icon or the new Messaging Hub button on the Employee nav bar.



Tuesday, May 29 1:00 PM ET In both the Client Portal and employee Messaging Hub, the number of replies for a message is indicated via a speech bubble. In the message thread, the original message is at the top followed by the most recent reply.



Like the other functions in the Client Portal, you control which client users have access to the Messaging function. As a reminder, you need to have your Implementation or Account Manager turn on the Client Portal for your system.



Integration of new or upgraded Instant Messaging functionality and other messaging features in the Messaging Hub






Wiley Integration in Tx Plus

To achieve consistency in the problems/goals/objectives/ interventions in Tx Plus plans – which ones are used and how they are described – you can now contract to use the Wiley treatment planning "library" as part of Tx Plus. If you select "Use Wiley" when you are building a Tx Plus plan, the predefined problems/goals/objectives/interventions for the treatment plan you select are available via dropdowns.





You can set up your system to use Wiley exclusively or let staff use Wiley and free-form entry for the different components in a Tx Plus plan.

Using the Wiley treatment planning library requires an addendum to your contract. For more information, contact contracts@credibleinc.com. Once you have contracted to use Wiley, your Implementation or Account Manager needs to turn on the functionality in your system.

Tx Plus Templates and Other Enhancements


To save time when building Tx Plus plans, you can now save existing plans as templates and have staff use them instead of building the treatment plan structure on the fly. You can also use the new Admin function TxPlus Templates to build a Tx Plus template and manage existing templates. Because the Admin function is just for templates, the "Builder" screen does not have the Program dropdown and Date fields that are in the Client Tx Plus Builder screen.

For existing Tx Plus templates, you can view, edit, and delete them from the Tx Plus Templates list screen.



When you are in the Client TxPlus Builder screen for a client, you can load an existing template and use it as is or make changes and save it as a new template. The other option is to save an existing Tx Plus plan as a template. In this scenario, the system does not retain the program selected, any dates entered, or any documentation entered against the plan. In addition, start dates are not required like they are when you save a Tx Plus plan for a client.


- Active flag to control availability of Tx Plus plan in a form
- Locking existing Tx Plus visits against Tx Plus plan edits
- New notification trigger TxPlus Problem Add and Tx Plus support for existing treatment plan triggers
- Ability to make Tx Plus plans available in Client Portal
- Active Tx Plus plans in Client Profile Print View
- Autopopulating of end date in sublevels without one
- Collapse All/Expand All link in Tx Plus form
- ADD TX PLUS link in web form (eliminates need for Intake nav bar)

Assigning Billing Groups to Your Employees



To help ensure that employees select the correct billing group for each visit, you can now control which ones are available when they enter, sign and submit, and update a visit.

If you do not assign billing groups to an employee, all groups will be available in the Billing Group dropdown. If you assign one or more billing groups, only the assigned ones will be available. As shown on the right, there is one exception to this. If you assign one or more billing groups and have an unassigned billing group set as the default, the default plus the assigned ones will be in the dropdown.




When the default billing group is set or changed in the Employee Billing Groups screen, it will be reflected in the Employee Profile and vice versa. You can assign a default to an employee without assigning any billing groups (all billing groups will be available in the Billing Groups dropdown). The new Billing Groups function does not affect the functionality behind the billing group assignment for Billing Matrix entries.

Reporting e-Prescribing G-Codes


With the new ability to report on G-codes, it will be easier for your organization to obtain the Medicare incentive for e-prescribing. When you sign and submit a visit or update a



completed visit, you can flag the visit for an eRx G-code. Behind the scenes, the system creates a secondary visit for billing purposes. If you follow the best practice of setting the eRx G-code Billing Matrix entry to Auto Approve, it will free up your clinical staff from having to approve the secondary visit.



In the Visit Details screen, you can click the Secondary (or Primary) link in the Merged/GCode field to view the details for that visit.



Because the eRx G-code visit is a secondary visit, it will not decrement an authorization.

To use the eRx G-code functionality, you have to create the visit via a web form. You can control which employees can create eRx G-code visits with a new Security Matrix right. Note that you cannot undo (roll back) an eRx G-code primary/secondary split.
